



The Department for Education told the School Teachers' Review Body (STRB) a 2.8 per cent pay award "would be appropriate" for 2025-26, and schools would have to **find efficiencies** to fund it.

There is no way around it, this means more cuts for our schools. 76% of Primary schools – will not be able to afford their costs next year. Schools' costs for 2025-26 will rise by 3.4%, while mainstream school funding will increase by just 2.2%.

Be in no doubt this will affect you!

Pupil roles are already falling which effects our funding.

All we have left in our primaries are our staff, there are no glue sticks.

One less TA =

- **Less interventions for the children who need more time to understand**
- **No one but you to support the child who is in crisis daily**
- **30+ children no support (progress, progress, progress)**
- **No one to watch your class whilst you talk to a parent, sort out a disagreement between two children or nip to the toilet**
- **Less support for SEN pupils let's face it EHCPs don't cover 121 support anyway**
- **Colleagues and friends you've worked with for years facing redundancies**
