



The Department for Education told the School Teachers' Review Body (STRB) a 2.8 per cent pay award "would be appropriate" for 2025-26, and schools would have to **find efficiencies** to fund it.

There is no way around it, this means more cuts for our schools.

94% of secondary schools – will not be able to afford their costs next year.

Schools' costs for 2025-26 will rise by 3.4%, while mainstream school funding will increase by just 2.2%.

- **further reduced curriculum – subjects like music, languages, art and design the creative subjects that our children so desperately need.**
- **increase in the number of children taught in classes of over 30.**
 - ~ **More marking**

- **restriction in the variety of school trips that can be offered**
- **reduction in wellbeing and behaviour support**
- **support staff roles being condensed to incorporate several roles with less staff**
- **teacher expectations and workload significantly increasing**
